

DEVELOPMENT MANAGER JOB DESCRIPTION

Overview

The North Shore Girls Soccer Club (“NSGSC”) is one the largest clubs in Canada with 2600 registered youth girls and 300 women. The Club's Mission is "to provide all players the opportunity to play soccer in a supportive and rewarding environment that emphasizes fun, fair play and skill development at a level that fits their interest and ability, and to create a challenging environment for players who aspire to reach their full potential."□

The NSGSC has been very successful in providing a variety of development programs for all age groups, and we are the service provider to the North Vancouver School District for its high school soccer academy program for boys and girls. The NSGSC provides many of our programs through our indoor soccer facility ("the Bubble"), which is the largest of its kind in BC.

The NSGSC is seeking to hire several individuals for the new position of Development Manager prior to commencement of the 2015-16 season. The ideal candidates will have a passion and enthusiasm for working with female soccer players and volunteer coaches.

Development Managers will oversee a specific age group of players or cluster of like-minded players and will be a main point of contact for players, parents and volunteer coaches in their cluster.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Be the technical lead for volunteer coaches and staff on club philosophy and curriculum
- Attend training sessions through the season (weekly) to support the volunteer coach and the session development
- Attend games through the season

- Oversee the progression of players holistically (physical, technical/tactical, social/emotional, mental)
- Support the pathway for players with in season transfers (if felt appropriate)
- Provide player evaluations
- Provide coach feedback and support
- Support with the selection process for the following year teams
- Be a connection to parents with questions / information /feedback

Competencies & Skills Required

1. Minimum Provincial B Coaching License or international equivalent
2. Knowledge of and support for the Canadian Soccer Association's Long Term Player Development (LTPD) model and Wellness To World Cup framework.
3. Experience with coaching female soccer player and the design of associated technical programs.
4. Is in good standing with governing bodies of soccer (Local, Provincial and National).
5. Must be fluent in English.
6. Must undergo a Criminal Record Check

Compensation

Annual compensation will be between \$4,000 and \$10,000, based on hours of work and assignment to a particular cluster.
